

Mill Creek Park 2017 Campground Rules, Regulations and Information

To qualify for In-District rates, you must be a resident of – or own property in the Clark County Park District (current real estate tax statements must be provided as proof).

ABSOLUTELY NO ATV RIDING IS ALLOWED IN THE CAMPGROUND

1. Fees - \$22.00 per night Weekdays	\$25.00 per night on Weekdays
\$25.00 per night Weekends	\$28.00 per night on Weekends
\$28.00 per night Holiday Weekends	\$30.00 per night on Holiday Weekends

Weekday discounts will apply Sunday thru Wednesday nights (excluding Holidays)

2. Checkout time in the campground is 12:00 p.m., 4 p.m. on Holidays, Sundays and Mondays.
3. Holiday Reservations:
 - A. 3 night minimum – no weekday discounts will apply
 - B. All holiday reservations must be paid in full at the time reservation is made.
4. Non-Holiday Reservations

All non-holiday reservations made will require a 1 night deposit. The 1 night deposit must be paid at the time the reservation is made. The balance is due upon arrival. (Example: If you reserve the same site for the entire season on the weekends, you must pay a one night deposit for every weekend.)
5. Notification of cancellations must be made to the Clark County Park District or the Mill Creek Park Gate House within the appropriate time period of the reservation date to receive a refund of any deposits made. (See Appendix A or Reservation Requirements on the website www.clarkcountyparkdistrict.com)
6. Credit vouchers will not be issued in lieu of deposits after the deadline.
7. You may have one (1) tent in addition to your camping unit at no charge. Otherwise you will be required to pay for a tent double up. (Example: A camper plus one tent is allowed, setting a second tent will double the nightly camping fee.) See the campground host for payment of the additional tent. No more than one additional tent will be allowed.
8. No firewood may be brought in from out of district or from a USDA firewood quarantined area due to EAB (Emerald Ash Borer). No pallets may be used as firewood due to the possibility of nails. Firewood is available for purchase at the Gate House. No firewood may be cut within the Park. Fire rings must be kept on stone pads.

9. Campers must be set on the stone pads. Driving through the grass is prohibited to reverse set campers.
10. Quiet hours are 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
11. All campers are required to bag and dispose of their trash in the designated dumpsters. Mill Creek Park employees will not pick up trash at your site. Littering your site with trash will be subject to fines.
12. All pets must be on a leash, or kenneled and must be attended at all times. **YOU ARE REQUIRED TO CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET AT ALL TIMES IN ALL AREAS.**
13. Advanced reservations do not lock in the price as the Clark County Park District reserves the right to adjust prices as necessary.
14. Please check the announcement boards or our website for Weekend and Holiday events scheduled throughout the year, you can find a complete schedule online at clarkcountyparkdistrict.com.
15. Water hoses must be disconnected from the hydrants and must be stored on stone pads on grass mowing days, generally on Mondays and Tuesdays.
16. Campground pads will be occasionally sprayed with a contact weed killer on Mondays or Tuesday. Notices will be posted at the entrances of each campground section during the spray event.
17. TWO motorized vehicles per campsite. Additional parking is available at the overflow parking lot and the concessions stand parking lot.
18. Washing vehicles or boats in campground is allowed. Campers can be washed for a fee of \$10 per unit per day.
19. Wastewater must be disposed of through proper sanitary facilities. Do not discharge wastewater on the ground.
